Close your eyes. Sit together in silence and breath loudly in rhythm with each other 20 times. Count as you breath.

Each partner completes these sentences to the other.

I think you are good because... I think you are beautiful because... I think you are treasured because... I think you are a good provider because... I think you are worthy because... I do not like the feeling of ... I do not like how you... I do not like when you... I do not like where vou... *I do not like that in you because* Today I realise that... Today I now know... Today I am more aware that... Today I will consider... Today I will try to ... I love you because...
